

An electric guitar with locking tremolo system is required.


Amplification for the guitar is necessary.

Guitar and orchestra notation:

Tremolo bar:

The bracket denotes the highest and the lowest the tremolo system can get, and the line indicates the pitch at which the guitarist should approach.



Left hand pizzicato:

Plug the indicated open string with the left band forefinger.

Col Legno Battuto:

Hit the indicated note with the wood of the bow.

Bartok pizzicato

Place the forefinger of the right hand underneath the string and pull upwards and release so that the string snaps against the fingerboard
